

Mandatory Professional Licensure Disclosure

Per U.S. Federal Regulations, 34 CFR § 668.50 (2016 Rules), in preparation for the adoption of 34 C.F.R. §668.43 (2019 Rules), and in compliance with the State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (SARA) Manual version 19.2, The University of Tulsa provides the following disclosure related to the educational requirements for professional licensure and certification. This Disclosure is limited to the University's determination of whether the programs in *Elementary Education, English Education, Math Education, and Music Education*, if successfully completed, would be sufficient to meet the educational licensure or certification requirements for teaching. TU cannot provide verification of an individual's ability to meet licensure or certification requirements unrelated to its educational programming.

Furthermore, this disclosure does not account for changes in state law or regulation that may affect your application for licensure and occur after this disclosure has been made. At the conclusion of the Education programs in *Elementary Education, English Education, Math Education, and Music Education*, graduates are eligible for a standard teaching certificate in Oklahoma. Graduates obtain a standard teaching certificate by completing all state-required exams and completing the application process through the Oklahoma State Department of Education.

TU has designed an educational program for *Elementary Education, English Education, Math Education, and Music Education*, that if successfully completed in conjunction with successfully obtaining an Oklahoma standard teaching license is sufficient to meet the requirement for a reciprocal teaching license in the following states:
